In January of 1967, a meeting was held at North Carolina State University with some of the county YMW Club officers for the purpose of discussing plans for YMW during the year of 1967. Plans were made for a state banquet to be held in April and invitations were issued to all YMW Club members in the state to attend.

The banquet was held at the Faculty Club at North Carolina State on April 29 with approximately 30 people in attendance. During the evening, state officers were elected as follows: Arthur Lee Wiggins, President, Hertford County; Olivia Raper, Vice-President, Davidson County; Leola Meador, Secretary-Treasurer, Rockingham County; Ted Bright, Historian, McDowell County. Following the banquet, a period of discussion was held, and tentative plans were made for a state conference to be held in the summer. The conference was planned for Roanoke Island 4-H Camp during the weekend of August 5-6. These plans were made provided there would be as many as 50 reservations received with deposits at least ten days in advance.

During June, a meeting was held with some of the state YMW officers and tentative plans were made for the state conference. The state conference was not held because ten days prior to the conference, we did not have but eleven reservations for the state conference.
