

4-H CHURCH SUNDAY

The 4-H Church Sunday material was prepared under the direction of Cleo Jones, 4-H Specialist. Mr. Leo Hawkins, Family Relations Specialist, N. C. State Extension Service, wrote the worship service. Mr. Hawkins is a former minister and has had experience working with young people for several years. "Goals and Values" was the subject of the 1967 4-H Church Sunday programs. Counties were encouraged to enlarge and adapt this information to suit their needs and to allow the boys and girls taking part on the program to use their own ideas and interpretations of this material.

Reports received from 58 counties indicate the following participation in 4-H Church Sunday this year: 505 different churches in these counties participated; 550 different clubs in these counties participated; 459 programs were given by 4-H members; 8,177 4-H members attended the services; 5,662 4-H members participated in these services; 34,574 people attended the services; 37 community 4-H vesper programs were held; 8 county-wide 4-H vesper programs were held; 16 county-wide Church Sunday programs were held; 72 radio programs regarding Church Sunday were presented; 72 church related 4-H community service projects were conducted; 110 news articles were written; 1,137 adult leaders assisted with the church Sunday programs; and 1,470 adult leaders attended the Church Sunday services.
