

4-H FORESTRY CAMP

In 1967, the North Carolina 4-H Forestry Camp was again held at Camp Millstone, June 12-17. There are two primary purposes for Forestry Camp; namely, to help members acquire an understanding and know-how needed to be a successful timber owner and grower, and to help the member develop leadership abilities and skills so that upon return home he will assist other 4-H members to recognize and take advantage of forestry as an important natural resource.

Seven classes were conducted; namely, Timber Measurements, Silviculture and Soils, Equipment and Safety, Fencing, Forest Protection, Map and Compass, Site Preparation, Stand Conversion and 4-H Record Keeping. Sixty-nine boys between the ages of 14 and 19 participated in the camp this year.
