

4-H REPORT-TO-THE STATE

The 4-H Report to the State Program was continued in 1967. The program attempted to accomplish the same objectives as outlined in the 1966 Annual Report.

The team consisted of the following members: Jane Morris, Mecklenburg; Judy McLean, Henderson; Kathy Gentry, Person; Charles Williams, Johnston and John Pat McDowell, Edgecombe. The program format again consisted of oral presentations by three team members and vocal talent numbers by the other two.

The team made visits and presentations in the following cities: Raleigh, Edenton, New Bern, Durham, Lumberton, Greensboro, Charlotte, Tryon, Morganton and Elkin. At each stop a program was presented before some local group. Over 1,000 people were in attendance at the ten meetings. Excellent press coverage was given to the tour. The team made 19 different radio and television appearances and held three press conferences.

The state-owned plane, The Carolina Cardinal, was again chartered to fly the team across the state. Expenses for the tour, as listed below, were provided by the Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation of Houston, Texas, and the N. C. 4-H Development Fund:
