

Negro Agents(Plan of Club Work for 1937

For the first time, beginning December 1, Negro Agents have a State Plan for 4-H Club Work.

Each County Agent made out individual plans for his county, giving the number of organization activities to be carried out; the number of projects planned for the county; method demonstrations for club members and annual days, such as club tours, picnics, camps, etc.

This plan has gone a long way in coordinating club work among Negro boys and girls. A number of the Agents in expressing themselves relative to the prospects for club work this year, stated that they really had some definite program for their county and plans, and that we would see club work at its best in the counties.

I feel that with the Plan of Work and the assistance being reached by Agents in their respective counties that already we can see marked progress and a larger number of boys and girls completing projects, keeping records and participating in worthwhile jobs on the farm this year. We have twenty-eight Plans for Negro Agents representing twenty-nine counties. We are putting forth every effort to carry out the Plan in each county, and adding to the Plan instead of falling short in any phase.
