

YMW PROGRAM

In the spring of 1964 banquets were held for the counties with YMW Clubs in the Southwestern and Western Districts and the Northwestern District. The Southwestern and Western District banquet was held on April 25 in Gaston County and the Northwestern District banquet was held on May 9 in Rockingham County.

During February of 1964 a planning conference was held with the state officers for the purpose of making plans for the annual conference and other business concerning YMW. This conference was held in Ricks Hall on the N. C. State campus.

Annual YMW Conference

Mr. Tom Hobgood, Extension Community Development Specialist, presented a lecture on community and community projects. Mrs. Peggy Clark and Miss Connie Jo Wells, Home Economists, Duke Power Company presented a demonstration and talk on the care and use of small appliances. Mr. John Glover, Extension Agricultural Engineering Specialist, presented a talk and illustrated lecture on Automotive Care and Safety. Another feature of the state conference was a lecture by Mr. James Forbes, IFYE from Scotland, on Agriculture and Youth Organizations in Scotland.

The following officers were elected: President - Olivia Raper, Davidson County; Vice President - George Hanner, Guilford County; Secretary-Treasurer - Sally Ann Barber, Hertford County; and Historian - Ann Fields, Guilford County.

Two committees were appointed--one to make revisions in the Superior Service Award and another to present for club consideration a constitution and bylaws.
