

COLLEGIATE 4-H CLUBS

Collegiate 4-H Clubs are organized at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and at North Carolina State of the University of North Carolina at Raleigh. These clubs provide continued opportunity for leadership development of young people, fellowship for those who have similar interests, and service to the 4-H program. Members of the club are former 4-H Club members who are now attending these universities.

Fred H. Wagoner serves as Advisor for the North Carolina State Collegiate Club, and Mary Sue Moser serves as Advisor for the University of North Carolina at Greensboro Collegiate Club. They both assisted the officers and members in planning their programs, in officer training, with part of their programs, and in helping plan and conduct service projects.

Each club has a monthly educational program. The North Carolina State Club meets every two weeks as a supper meeting in the Leazar Dining Hall with the other meeting being devoted to a business session. The University of North Carolina at Greensboro Club meets each third Tuesday in the School of Home Economics Building. The North Carolina State Club conducted a service project at the North Carolina State Fair which involved operating a checking booth for coats and articles for the visitors. They also made wood North Carolina identification tags for the delegates to National 4-H Club Congress and purchased Bibles for placing in the cottages of the new 4-H camp and in some of the other camps. The University of North Carolina at Greensboro Club assisted with the Northwestern District 4-H Leaders' Banquet and with the Guilford County 4-H Achievement Program. Both of these events were held on their campus. The two clubs held three joint social programs during the year.
