

### STATE 4-H FORESTRY CAMP

The State 4-H Forestry Camp provided a week's intensive training in forestry for 4-H boys. The two main purposes were: (1) to help members acquire the understanding and know-how needed to be a successful timber owner and grower; and (2) to help members develop into a leader who will go back home eager to help other 4-H members recognize and take advantage of forestry opportunities.

The camp was held at Millstone 4-H Camp, June 22 - 27, with 85 members and 12 extension agents in attendance. Classes taught included: Equipment and Safety, Tree Study and Wildlife, Forest Protection, Silviculture, Timber Measurements, and Fencing and Constructing Right Angles.

The camp program is planned and conducted by the Extension Forestry Specialist and the State 4-H Club Office. The Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company was the donor for the camp.
