

4-H KEY AWARD PROGRAM

The N. C. 4-H Key Award Program is designed to motivate and stimulate greater use of the abundance of Junior Leadership among 4-H Club members. The real aim being to encourage the development of outstanding citizens.

The awards in the program for boys and girls scoring a minimum of 100 points on the application are:

boys: Gold tie clasp, key, and framed certificate

girls: Gold bracelet, key, and framed certificate

The keys are appropriately engraved with the name of the recipient.

Each county is eligible to submit applications for 1 boy and 1 girl or 1% of boy membership and 1% of girl membership.

Cities Service Oil Company is donor of the program. And in addition to the awards provides a certain number of scholarships. Also in 1964 the donor provided funds for a banquet during State 4-H Club Week for all current and past winners of the Key Award; 311 key award winners were in attendance.
