

4-H DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM

Thirty different demonstrations are provided in North Carolina to give 4-H'ers special training in preparing educational information on various subjects and to offer them an opportunity to express themselves before different audiences. The demonstration program involves many different donors, 4-H adult leaders, the club members' parents, extension personnel, subject matter specialists, and many others interested in youth development. Community 4-H Club leaders, extension agents and cooperating agencies have given many hours in training the 4-H boys and girls.

Two new demonstrations, Rural Civil Defense and Egg Cookery, were added this year.

Each of the nine districts conducted District Demonstration Day programs during the month of June. Records indicate the greatest participation ever experienced in North Carolina.
