

4-H DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM

Thirty different demonstrations are provided in North Carolina to give 4-H'ers special training in preparing educational information on various subjects and to offer them an opportunity to express themselves before different audiences. The demonstration program involves many different donors, 4-H adult leaders, the club member's parents, Extension personnel, subject-matter specialists, and many others interested in youth development. Community 4-H Club leaders, extension agents and cooperating agencies have given many hours in training the 4-H boys and girls.

Each of the nine districts conducted District Demonstration Day programs during the month of June. Records indicate the greatest participation ever experienced in North Carolina.
