State 4-H Club Week was held at North Carolina State University during the week of July 26 - July 29. The program was attended by 1,202 4-H Club members, leaders, and agents.

The 4-H Club Week features were as follows: The program opened with the Presentation of Colors and a concert by the 2nd Marine Aircraft Wing Band.
