

N. C. STATE FAIR

Eighteen county 4-H exhibits and one Y.M.W. exhibit were presented at the State Fair. Subjects ranged from leadership development, organization, safety, conservation, community beautification, gardening, civil defense, electric, careers, and poverty to world service through 4-H.

\$4300 in premium money was provided for the 4-H exhibits and \$225 for the Y.M.W. exhibit.

Placing of exhibits by judges:

First - Hyde County
Second - Alamance County
Third - Iredell County
Fourth - Wayne County

The exhibits were educational, attractive, and promoted the image of 4-H. Leaders, club members, resource people and agents were involved in planning and developing the ideas.

It is estimated that several hundred thousand people visited the 4-H area of exhibits.

In addition to the counties, individual 4-H members exhibited in crafts, clothing, poultry, foods and live-stock.
