

4-H WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CONFERENCE

The annual 4-H Wildlife Conservation Conference was held at Millstone 4-H Camp and Mitchell 4-H Camp, August 9 - 14, 1965. The purpose of these conferences is to encourage wise use of our natural resources. Sixty-two boys and girls attended the conference at Millstone 4-H Camp, and seventy-eight attended the conference at Mitchell 4-H Camp. Both of these conferences are sponsored by the Federal Cartridge Corporation of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The 4-H Staff and the Extension Wildlife Specialist jointly plan and direct these conferences. Instructions are provided by Extension Service Specialist, representative of the North Carolina Wildlife Resource Commission, and the North Carolina Department of Conservation and Development. The 4-H members receive instructions in soil and water conservation, forestry and wildlife conservation, boating and water safety and hunter safety.

Delegates to this conference are selected on the basis of their accomplishments in the 4-H Wildlife Project.
