

4-H KEY AWARD PROGRAM

Receiving Key Awards through Cities Service Oil Company Sponsorship were 70 boys and 105 girls from 66 different counties. This was an increase of 16 over 1964. Each recipient received a beautiful lettered and framed certificate in addition to the key and tie clasp for boys and key and bracelet for girls.

Forty-nine Key Award scholarship applications were submitted from 37 different counties. This was an increase from 29 applications and 24 counties the year before.
