

COLLEGIATE 4-H CLUBS

North Carolina has four active Collegiate 4-H Clubs. They are located on the campuses of North Carolina State University, the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Campbell and Pembroke Colleges. The college clubs provide continued opportunities for leadership development of young people, fellowship for those who have similar interest, service to the 4-H program and an opportunity to keep abreast of the new developments in the 4-H program. Former 4-H members or those interested in affiliation with the club can become members.

Fred H. Wagoner serves as advisor for the North Carolina State University 4-H Club and Mary Sue Moser serves as advisor for the University of North Carolina at Greensboro 4-H Club. The Pembroke and Campbell Clubs were organized in the fall of 1966. Lyman Dixon assisted a former 4-H member, John Capps of Kinston, in the organization of the Campbell Club and Mrs. Reba Lowery, Dean of Women at Pembroke College and a 4-H Leader, was responsible for organizing the Pembroke Club.

Monthly educational programs are conducted by each Club. The North Carolina State University Club began a service project during the year of teaching a class in Courtesy and Manners each month at the new Community Correctional Center in Raleigh. This is a project conducted by the Prison Department for prisoners one month prior to their release to aid them in preparing for adjustment again to Society.
