

## NORTH CAROLINA STATE FAIR

A major change was made in the 4-H exhibit section at the State Fair this year. 4-H booths took on a "new look." All old wooden structures were torn down and replaced with attractive portable booth dividers covered in green rayon drapery fabric. Also the eight foot back wall space of each exhibit space was created by a similar portable hollow aluminum rail covered in the green cloth.

The former eighteen county 4-H exhibits were consolidated into twelve. Three other display units, one for competitive 4-H Insect Collections, another for Crafts and an Educational Exhibit on Science in 4-H, completed the 4-H section.
