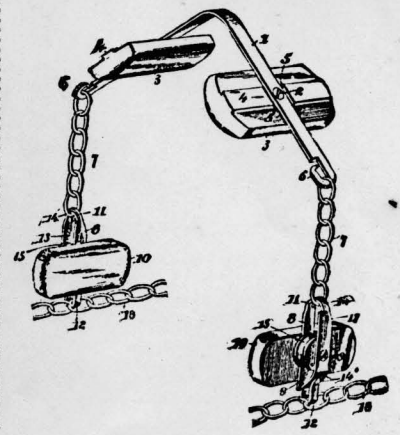

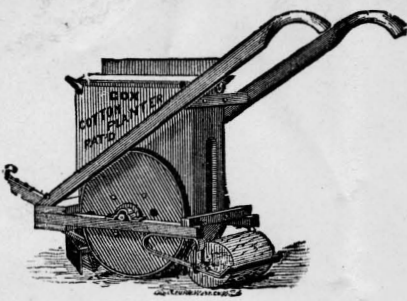
Dear Willie

pleasant service.

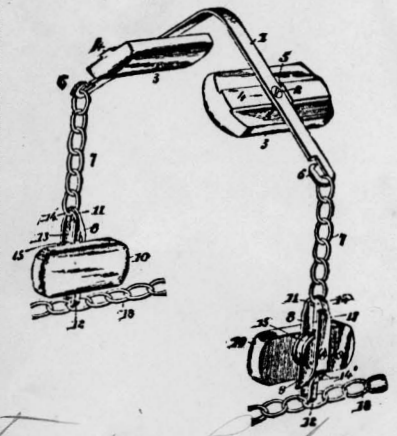
The Cyden College Commencement came of Friday and
