

### PROJECTS

The kind of projects vary somewhat with the different sections of the State and with the agents' plan of work. Members have been enrolled in the following clubs or projects this year:

Poultry, pig, sheep, calf, corn, cotton, potato, soybean, and tobacco.

The object is to use the boys and girls to aid in developing the agriculture of the State and to use agriculture to enrich the life of boys and girls of the farm.

The aim in conducting these projects is to demonstrate the value of grazing crops, balanced rations, good care and pure bred stock in growing livestock and proper fertilization, soil preparation, cultivation and seed selection in growing crops.

### METHOD OF INSTRUCTION.

Bulletins, circulars, letters, meetings, personal visits and demonstrations are all used in instructing club members. More group meetings were held this year than heretofore. This was made possible thru the organized clubs. A still greater use of group meetings will increase the efficiency and enlarge the results of the work.

All literature pertaining to the projects has been prepared under the supervision of the subject matter heads, as has been the rule in the past. We did not have, however, suitable literature for club projects. We especially need manuals on pig, sheep, corn, potato and cotton projects. We need literature simply and plainly written and illustrated for club work.
