

Negro Home Poultry

There has been a noticeable growth in the number of homes being reached in poultry work by the Negro Home Demonstration Agents. Much of the work has been carried on at monthly club meetings and in cooperation with other organizations already established in the communities.

The Guilford County Negro Agent says that at such gatherings the agents meet the mass of the folk and many of her projects are put across by interesting men and women.

The Robeson County Agent reports one member in the Greenville Club who has over three hundred chickens. This woman made fifty dollars for the sale of chickens and eggs in the fall. Another club member brought her own and the children's clothes with poultry money.

There were 851 individuals enrolled in poultry work with 340 members completing the project. Twenty-five different homes adopted improved practices relative to the home poultry work.
