Here is the 1946 Suggested List of Books for Home Demonstration Club Women prepared by Marjorie Beal of the State Library Commission -- lists of past years are good, too, for credit towards certificate.

We went over the thousand mark this year awarding certificates to 1,024 women, and I am so proud of this achievement. It wasn't easy for many of these women to read and review three books, and I know too, that the home agents must have been ingenious in finding time for so many reviews. We do want to keep our standards high, and we can't do it if we accept very light reading and poor reviews. I hope you will write and tell me how you have worked the reviews into your program.

Please keep in mind the requirements for a certificate, and see that your club women have the information, too. This year, we are stipulating that at least one of the three books must be non-fiction.

The Requirements:

1. A club woman must have read and reviewed 3 books from the suggested book lists compiled by the N. C. Library Commission, and reviewed these books before her club or a similar group. At least one of the three books must be non-fiction.
2. Your list of women eligible for the award must be sent to me by October 15. Include the name of the women, the books she has read, and the authors of the books.
3. The County Librarians have copies of the reading list, and will check with you the books available in the local library.

This project can mean so much to the home demonstration club women, and I am sure that you will continue to encourage them to read good books and to own some.
