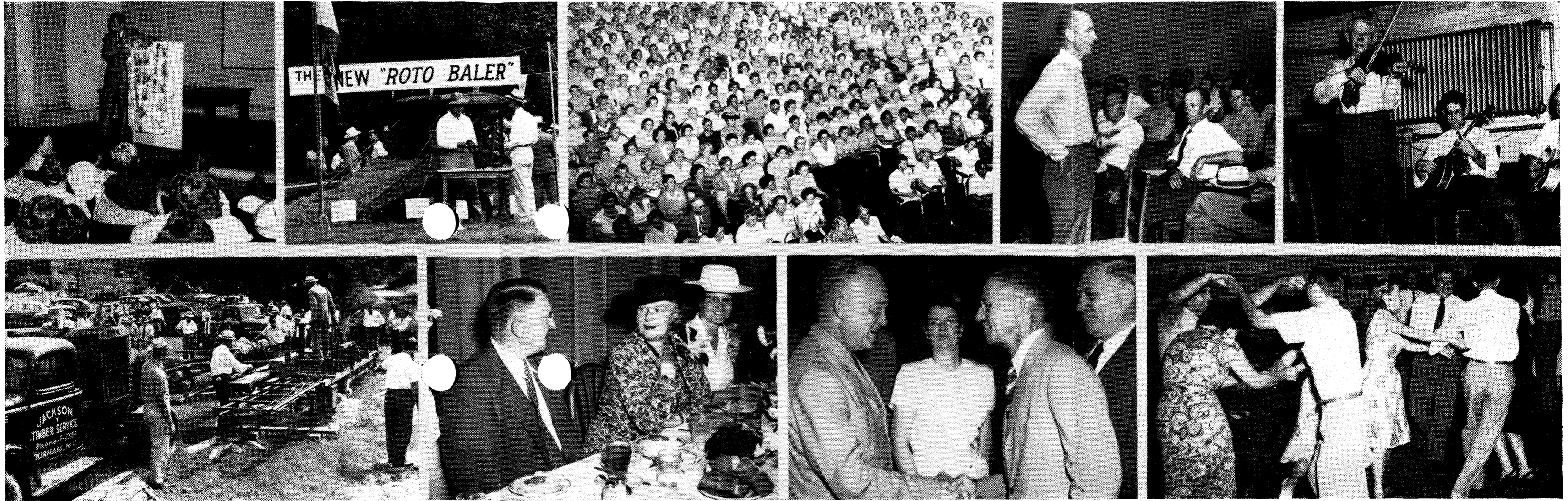

Look What's Planned This Year

1. **Lectures by outstanding national speakers** will be given on state, national and international affairs affecting rural people.

2. **Talks and discussions** will feature new and improved methods and procedures for farm and home activities, including crop and livestock production, farm mechanization, rural health, family relationships, house

furnishings and other points involved in better family living.

3. **Exhibits and demonstrations** on home equipment will emphasize electrical appliances. Others will include the latest in farm machinery. There will be a number of demonstrations of interest to both farmers and homemakers.

4. **Tours** will be made of historical sites in Raleigh as well as to the College and Experiment Station farms.

5. **Recreation** will include singing, square dances, and other enjoyable features.

6. **Contests** will be held and valuable prizes awarded to the winners. (See list of prizes back of folder.)
